The Dewey Decimal Classification System

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Grade: 4

7 week unit / 40 Minutes each

January 4:

Objective: Students will be able to identify that DDCS organizes the library

Materials: DDS DVD, Essential Library Skills

Lesson Procedure: (location: story steps)

- review DDCS from 3rd grade

- watch video of DDS which explains each classification like a neighborhood
- questions?

January 11:

Objective: Students will be able to identify subjects in each Dewey range.

Materials: 100's boards (with pocket sheets), "books," guide sheets, procedure sheet,

index cards w/ Deweys listed.

Lesson Procedure: (location: back tables)

- recap video, each book has a location in the library, and the call number is like its address.
 - explain procedure and activity

Procedures for Dewey Decimal Neighborhoods

- 1. On each table, you will find index cards with "000" to "BIO" and an envelope with books to sort.
- 2. Along the back shelves, you will see "Neighborhoods" for each Dewey range.
- 3. As a group, sort your books into the Dewey category you believe they belong in by placing them on the index card. If you are stuck, use your guide sheet.
- 4. You may not have a book for each category, and you may have more than one book for some categories.
- 5. One at a time you will be chosen to go up to the neighborhoods posted along the shelves and place your books in the envelopes.
- 6. We will review the groups' selections as a class when all books have been placed.
 - wrap up & review

February 1:

Objective: Students will be able to select 3-4 books in their assigned Dewey range.

Materials: Dewey planning commercial sheets, clipboards

Lesson Procedure: (location: back tables)

- Ask students what the point of commercials are
- students select teammate and Dewey range at random
- take planning sheet and clipboard, go to range and select books, making sure to get a good representation of range
- write title and author on back of planning sheet as well as a short summary of the book
 - stack all books on designated area so students will have the following week

February 8:

Objective: Students will be able to fill out planning sheet for DD commercials Materials: planning sheets, books they choose from past week, script sheets Lesson Procedure: (location: back tables)

- have students get books and folders from last week
- finish writing down author, titles, and summaries of each book
- once complete, start working on front of planning sheet
- return books to shelves for following week

February 22:

Objective: Students will be able to create video presentations of Dewey section. Materials: planning sheets, books they choose from past week, video camera & tripod Lesson Procedure: (location: back tables)

- distribute books and planning sheets
- students who have complete planning sheets can practice and go record commercials on story steps.
 - other students work on completing planning sheets

March 1:

Objective: Students will be able to create video presentations of Dewey section. Materials: planning sheets, books they choose from past week, video camera & tripod Lesson Procedure: (location: back tables)

- distribute books and planning sheets
- any group who has not recorded will do so

March 8:

Objective: Students will be able to evaluate knowledge of DDS. Materials: evaluation sheets, SmartBoard with commercials Lesson Procedure: (back tables)

- watch commercials in order of Dewey range
- complete evaluation sheets
- recap Dewey Decimal System
